

Teachers' Training on Authentic Assessments

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The purpose of this training workshop is to educate teachers on how to integrate Authentic Assessment into teaching Family Literacy. The teachers will get familiar with the theoretical, as well as the practical aspect of applying Authentic Assessment in Family Literacy. They will be exposed to a variety of Authentic Assessments and learn how to apply them effectively and creatively in classrooms. There are several important learning objectives that we hope to accomplish by the end of the six hour workshop. The workshop will start off with teachers' presentation.

- Each teacher will present 5 different lesson plans that she/he developed and then receives constructive feedback afterwards.
- Teachers will learn of different Authentic Rubrics, how to develop and apply them appropriately in their respective classrooms.
- They will learn:
 - (8 different) self assessment of Oral Language
 - (12 different) self assessment of Reading
 - (2 different) self assessment of Speaking
 - (3 different) Portfolios
 - (3 different) self assessment of Writing
- Lastly, they will learn to how to apply/incorporate each one of these into their lesson plans.
